Two years ago, I purchased
crutches for him, as his feet
were so painful and sore, he
could hardly walk - In the
hot weather bed room
slippers are worn by him
for weeks at a time - Standing
and walking have made the
pain almost unbearable -
In High School, he was
excused from using the
swimming pool, due to the
water affecting his feet and the
fear it might have been
contagious to other students
